I. DEPARTMENTAL MATTERS IN THE REGULAR COURSE OF BUSINESS:

A. Arts & Venues Denver - Kent Rice

BR12-0732 *Approves a \$2,500,000 increase in the 2012 expenditure appropriation to the Arts and Venues Denver Special Revenue Fund (SRF) for operating funds for Arts & Venues Denver to recognize the increased number of events over original expectations. Increased spending is offset by increased revenue to the SRF in the amount of \$7,155,340; this supplemental has no General Fund impact.

B. Department of Safety - Regina Huerter

BR12-0734 *Amends the existing agreement with the Mental Health Center of Denver to add funding in the amount of \$735,999 from the federal Substance Abuse Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) grant for Denver Approach to Recovery Through Treatment services for Drug Court clients related to substance abuse and mental health issues and to extend the contract through September 29, 2013 (GE94065 (1)).

BR12-0735 *Amends the agreement with the Substance Abuse Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) grant in the amount of \$854,799 to extend the grant funding through September 29, 2013 for DARTT services for Drug Court clients related to substance abuse and mental health issues (GC93016 (1)).

C. Environmental Health - Elizabeth Babcock

BR12-0736 *Amends the contract with Populus, LLC, to extend the contract through May 1, 2013 and to expend federal American Reinvestment and Recovery Act (ARRA) grant funds in the amount of \$41,000 to provide customer support, data management, work flow management, energy advising, energy advisor training, and other project management support for the Denver Energy Challenge program (ENVHL-201204731-00).

D. General Services - Michael Romero

BR12-0741 *Adds \$2,050,000 to the master purchase order with Faris Machinery Company, Inc. for OEM Elgin™ Street Sweeper parts and components to accommodate anticipated spending through September 30, 2017.

E. Public Works - Nancy Kuhn

RR12-0738 *Accepts the final subdivision plat for Stapleton Filing No. 36, a residential area of approximately 156 acres at Northfield Blvd. and Verbena St. in Council District 11.

RR12-0739 *Accepts the final subdivision plat for Stapleton Filing No. 37, a multi-unit residential area of approximately 15 acres at Northfield Blvd. and Xenia St. in Council District 11.
