Dedicates a parcel of land as part of the public right-of-way of Navajo Street at its intersection with 33rd Avenue in Council District 9. The Committee approved filing this resolution by consent on 3-27-14.

CR14-0240 A resolution laying out, opening and establishing as part of the City street system a parcel of land as Tejon Street at its intersection with West 33rd Avenue.

Dedicates a parcel of land as part of the public right-of-way of Tejon Street at its intersection with 33rd Avenue in Council District 9. The Committee approved filing this resolution by consent on 3-27-14.

CR14-0241 A resolution laying out, opening and establishing as part of the City street system a parcel of land as a public alley bounded by West 35th Avenue, Tejon Street, West 36th Avenue and Vallejo Street.

Approves a \$2 million contract with Southwest Airlines Company to execute a Reimbursement Agreement for Southwest's purchase of five (5) jet bridges for the Concourse C West 5 gate expansion project at Denver International Airport (PLANE-201415038-00). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-28-14. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 3-27-14.

CB14-0244 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Prophet Brand Strategy, Inc. related to professional consulting services at Denver International Airport.

Approves a \$1.8 million, one-year contract with Prophet Brand Strategies for customer segmentation information, brand positioning, and other predictive analytics at Denver International Airport (201414903). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-28-14. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 3-26-14.

CB14-0201 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Fifth Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Marsh USA, Inc., to provide insurance brokerage and risk management consulting services.

Adds \$70,000 and one additional year to the existing contract with Marsh USA through 3-31-15 (for a new total of \$564,000) for City property and liability insurance brokerage services and risk management consulting services (CE02088-05). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-28-14. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 3-20-14.

CB14-0229 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Agreement between the City and County of Denver and O.J. Watson Company, Inc., to procure twenty Monroe Snow Plows and one Schwarze Sweeper financed through a lease purchase agreement.

Approves a contract with O.J. Watson Company, Inc. to obtain twenty (20) Monroe Snow Plows System and one (1) Schwarze Sweeper (201414666) for \$2,228,085 financed through a lease purchase agreement. The last regularly scheduled meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-28-14. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 3-19-14.

CB14-0230 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Wagner Equipment Co., to procure two Caterpillar 160 M2 Road Graders financed through a lease purchase agreement.

Approves a contract with Wagner Equipment Co. to obtain two (2) Caterpillar 160 M2 Road Graders for \$597,129 financed through a lease purchase agreement (201414656). Approves a contract with Transwest Freightliner to obtain three (3) Freightliner Coronado SD Tractor Trucks and twenty (20) Freightliner 114 SD Cab and Chassis (201414679) for \$2,836,996 financed through a lease purchase agreement. CB14-0233 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Rush Truck Centers of Colorado, Inc., to procure forty-two Peterbilt Cab and Chassis financed through a lease purchase agreement.

Approves a contract with Rush Truck Centers of Colorado to obtain forty-two (42) Peterbilt Cab and Chassis for \$10,601,433.24 financed through a lease purchase agreement (201414664). The last regularly scheduled meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-28-14. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 3-19-14.

CB14-0234 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Power Equipment Company, to procure two Volvo L-150G Wheel Loaders financed through a lease purchase agreement.

Approves a contract with Power Equipment Company to obtain two (2) Volvo L-150G Wheel Loaders for \$662,616 financed through a lease purchase agreement (201414681). The last regularly scheduled meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-28-14. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 3-19-14.

CB14-0235 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Colorado Kenworth, Inc., to procure one Kenworth K270 Loadmaster Elite Rear Loader Refuse Truck financed through a lease purchase agreement.

Approves a contract with Colorado Kenworth to obtain one (1) Kenworth K270 Loadmaster Elite Rear Loader Refuse Truck for \$116,616.90 financed through a lease purchase agreement (201414665). The last regularly scheduled meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-28-14. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 3-19-14.

CB14-0242 A bill for an ordinance authorizing the purchase of capital equipment from the Planned Fleet Replacement Fund.

Approves the purchase of one \$74,700 bucket truck for the Denver Police Department's police surveillance camera program financed through the Planned Fleet Replacement Fund. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 3-27-14.

Health, Safety, Education & Services

CB13-1005 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Loan Agreement between the City and County of Denver and The Housing Authority of the City and County of Denver, to provide rental housing assistance.

Approves a loan agreement with the Denver Housing Authority to provide an \$800,000 performance loan for the construction of a 77 unit mixed-income rental housing project (Mariposa Phase IV). Eighteen of the units will be replacement public housing units; 34 units will be affordable for households with incomes between 50% and 60% of the Area Median Income (AMI); and 24 units will be market rate units. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-28-14. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 1-7-14.

CB14-0090 A bill for an ordinance approving an Eighth Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Mental Health Center of Denver to provide behavioral health services.

Approves an eighth amendment to the agreement with Mental Health Center of Denver in the amount of \$90,000 through 12-31-14 to provide intensive treatment services (CE-71064 (8)). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-28-14. Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 2-13-14.

CB14-0167 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Amendment to Development Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Forest City Enterprises, Inc., related to affordable housing.

Amends the Stapleton Development Agreement between Forest City Enterprises, Inc. and the City & County of Denver to provide an added level of flexibility for current Stapleton homeowners by providing alternative options at the time of resale and expanding the buyer pool for existing Stapleton affordable units in Council District 11. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-28-14. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 3-11-14.

Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

CB14-0144 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Anderson Hallas Architects PC, to extend the term and increase the maximum contract amount.

Approves an amendment to the on-call agreement with Anderson Hallas Architects to extend existing architectural and technical on-call services for an additional 24 months and to increase the on call task order capacity from \$480,000 to \$960,000 (201205581). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-28-14. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 3-6-14.

CB14-0199 A bill for an ordinance changing the zoning classification for 12 South Garfield Street.

Approves the rezoning of 12 South Garfield Street from PUD #583 to G-RH-3 in Council District 10. A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD AT LEAST FOUR WEEKS AFTER PUBLICATION. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 3-25-14.

CB14-0216 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and David Owen Tryba Architects, to extend the term and increase the maximum contract amount.

Amends the on-call agreement with David Owen Tryba Architects for architectural and technical services to extend the term through 6-11-16 and to increase the on-call task order capacity from \$480,000 to \$960,000 (201205956). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-28-14. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 3-20-14.

CB14-0217 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Slaterpaull Architects, Inc., to extend the term and increase the maximum contract amount.

Amends the on-call agreement with Slaterpaull Architects for architectural and technical services to extend the term through 7-22-16 and to increase the on-call task order capacity from \$480,000 to \$960,000 (201205622). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-28-14. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 3-20-14.

CB14-0218 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Roth Sheppard Architects, LLP, to extend the term and increase the maximum contract amount.

Amends the on-call agreement with Roth Sheppard Architects for architectural and technical services to extend the term through 6-17-16 and to increase the on-call task order capacity from \$480,000 to \$960,000 (201205621). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-28-14. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 3-20-14.

CB14-0219 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Humphries Poli Architects PC, to extend the term and increase the maximum contract amount.

Amends the on-call agreement with Humphries Poli Architects for architectural and technical services to extend the term through 6-17-16 and to increase the on-call task order capacity from \$480,000 to \$960,000 (201205957). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-28-14. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 3-20-14.

CB14-0220 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Page Southerland Page, LLP, to extend the term and increase the maximum contract amount.

Amends the on-call agreement with Page Southerland Page, LLP for architectural and technical services to extend term through 6-17-16 and to increase the on-call task order capacity from \$480,000 to \$960,000 (201205623). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-28-14. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 3-20-14.

Authorizes the Manager of Finance to finance, through a capital lease purchase agreement with JPMorgan Chase Bank, the acquisition of fleet totaling an amount not to exceed \$18,763,065. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-21-14. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 3-19-14.

Health, Safety, Education & Services

CB14-0091 A bill for an ordinance approving a Seventh Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Colorado Coalition for the Homeless to provide housing, mental health and substance abuse treatment.

Approves a seventh amendment to the agreement with the Colorado Coalition for the Homeless in the amount of \$144,000 through 12-31-14 to provide Assertive Community Treatment "ACT" services to mentally ill-homeless persons in the Court to Community intervention program (CE-70053 (7)). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-21-14. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 2-13-14.

CB14-0140 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Amendment between the City and County of Denver and Third Way Center Inc to provide Residential Child Care Facility (RCCF) services.

Approves a contract with Third Way Center, Inc. in the amount of \$1,162,434.17 to provide placement and case management services to children in and out of home care (2012-05750-01). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-21-14. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 2-27-14.

CB14-0188 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Second Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and El Pueblo Boys' & Girls' Ranch, Inc. to provide Residential Child Care Facility (RCCF) services.

Approves a contract with El Pueblo Boys & Girls Ranch, Inc. in the amount of \$2,143,215 through 6-30-15 to provide placements and case management services to children in and out of home care through child welfare (2012-05738-02). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-21-14. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 3-13-14.

CB14-0221 A bill for an ordinance making an appropriation from the Developmental Disabilities Special Revenue Fund.

Appropriates \$869,000 from the fund balance in the Developmental Disabilities Special Revenue Fund (13304) to increase appropriations based on December's forecast of 2014 property tax revenue. This transaction is related to the Rocky Mountain Human Services contract (formerly known as Denver Options) for services provided to the developmentally disabled. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 3-20-14.

CB14-0222 A bill for an ordinance establishing a "Child Welfare Services" fund in the Human Services Special Revenue Fund and the means for authorizing expenditures from such fund.

Creates a fund in the Human Services Special Revenue Fund that will be a non-lapsing, cash-basis special revenue fund to help restrict and account for the receipt of the funds and expenditure of savings for child welfare services, in accordance with statute. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 3-20-14.

CB14-0224 A bill for an ordinance approving a Sixth Revival and Amendatory Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Aurora to continue joint operation of the Rocky Mountain Fire Academy.

Amends an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Aurora to extend and ratify the joint operation of the Rocky Mountain Fire Academy (RMFA) through 12-31-15 (RC6X005-6). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-21-14. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 3-20-14.

CB14-0227 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Second Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Housing Authority of the City and County of Denver, to extend the term.

Approves a contract extension through 5-21-14 with Denver Housing Authority to administer \$750,000 in Housing & Urban Development (HUD) Community Challenge Planning Grant – Housing Development Assistance Funds, to be used for affordable housing development (201102160). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-21-14. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 3-20-14.

Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

CB14-0202 A bill for an ordinance vacating Beekman Place west of Nepal Street, with reservations.

Vacates a right-of-way for the section of Beekman Place west of Nepal Street in Council District 11. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 3-20-14.

CB14-0203 A bill for an ordinance vacating Tract U as shown on the Subdivision Plat for Green Valley Ranch Filing No. 35, with reservations.

Vacates Green Valley Ranch Filing 35, Tract U (at Beekman Place and Nepal Street) in Council District 11. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 3-20-14.

Amends the on-call agreement with Shannon & Wilson, Inc. for geotechnical professional services to extend the term through 9-30-15, and to increase the on-call task order capacity from \$480,000 to \$960,000 (OC01282). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 4-21-14. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 3-20-14.
