I. DEPARTMENTAL MATTERS IN THE REGULAR COURSE OF BUSINESS:

A. Mayor's Office - Anthony Aragon

- RR12-0177 *Approves the Mayoral reappointments of Gwinavere Johnston, Gillian Silverman and Kent Talmage-Bowers to the Denver Commission on Cultural Affairs for a term effective immediately and expiring on August 31, 2012 or until a successor is duly appointed.
- RR12-0178 *Approves the Mayoral appointment of Yolanda Ortega to the Denver Latino Commission for a term effective immediately and expiring on June 1, 2013 or until a successor is duly appointed.

C. Budget and Management – Laurel Bandy

- BR12-0193 *Approves a supplemental request for \$1,300,000 from the General Fund Contingency to reimburse the State for extended Unemployment Insurance payments and to cover forecast shortfall in 2012 budget.

D. Career Service Authority - Bruce Backer

- BR12-0179 *Creates a new classification series for intern for the Department of Parks and Recreation.

E. Community Planning and Development - Kyle Dalton

- BR12-0194 Rezones property at 3198 Blake Street from C-MU-10 with waivers (commercial mixed-use, lower density, from Former Chapter 59) to C-MX-5 (urban center mixed-use, 1-5 stories) in Council District 9.

F. Denver International Airport - Brian Elms

- BR12-0187 *Adds \$443,000 and five years to the contract with Megadata subscription services for maintenance and support services software related to landing fees.
- BR12-0188 *Approves a 100% reimbursement funding agreement with the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) supporting the upgrade of the checked baggage resolution areas in the Terminal and adjacent garages on level three.
- BR12-0189 *Approves a \$500,000 on-call contract with Sogeti USA for technical systems support for the airport, such as operations systems design and Implementation and voice and data network services.

G. Finance - Alyssa White

- BR12-0186 *Adds \$300,000 to and extends the contract with Trustwave for Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard (PCI DSS) compliance validation services for two additional annually renewable terms.

H. Office of Economic Development - Seneca Holmes/Melissa Stirdivant

- BR12-0167 Amends the City's loan agreement with Denver Housing Authority to assure compliance with the Housing and Community Development Act of 1980 and the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 (Welfare Reform Act) and to clarify indemnification provisions.
- BR12-0168 Amends an existing contract with Denver Urban Renewal Authority to improve permanent residential owner-occupied housing to assure compliance with the federal Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996.
- BR12-0190 Amends an existing contract with Denver Neighborhood Revitalization, Inc. (DNRI) to: assure compliance with federal Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 (Welfare Reform Act) and revise the date to return program revenue.
- BR12-0191 Amends an existing contract with Denver Neighborhood Revitalization, Inc. (DNRI) to: assure compliance with federal Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 (Welfare Reform Act); outline provisions prohibiting employment of illegal aliens; and revise the date for submitting American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Job Reports.
- BR12-0192 *Approve a ten month (5/1/12-3/1/13) \$590,000 contract for youth employment (youth wages & stipends) and training services with Bayaud Payroll Services through Bridges to Work, General Fund and Workforce Investment Act (WIA) programs.

- RR12-0181 *Approves a revocable permit to Denver Bike Sharing to encroach into the right-of-way with bicycle docking stations at 6 locations: 745 E. 6th Avenue, 1301 Speer Blvd, 1405 Race St, 1509 17th St, 2701 17th St and 3041 N. Zuni St, in Council Districts 9 & 10.
- RR12-0182 *Approves a revocable permit to the University of Denver to encroach into the right-of-way with new fiber optic lines in the alley located between west of York St. and south of Jewell Ave in Council District 7.
- RR12-0183 *Approves a revocable permit to encroach into the right-of-way with planters and an ADA ramp along W. 13th Ave. at 419 W. 13th Ave in Council District 10.
- BR12-0184 *Approves an amendment with Huitt-Zollars to provide necessary additional services for the design of the University/Josephine, 1st to 6th Avenue Street Reconstruction and Storm Sewer Improvements in Council District 10 (CE91238).
