### I. DEPARTMENTAL MATTERS IN THE REGULAR COURSE OF BUSINESS:

#### A. Mayor's Office - Anthony Aragon

RR15-0696 \*Approves the Mayoral appointments of Anthony Aragon and Antonio Mendez as citizen representatives to the Denver Community Corrections Board for terms effective immediately and expiring 6-30-19, or until successors are duly appointed.

#### B. Budget and Management - Brendan Hanlon

BR15-0732 Approves supplemental 2015 budget requests for the Office of Independent Monitor, City Attorney's Office, Office of Economic Development, Office of the Municipal Public Defender and the Office of Human Resources in the amount of \$1,537,000 from the City's General Fund Contingency.

#### C. Denver International Airport - Amy Raaz

RR15-0723 \*Approves a contract with Michael L. Cheroutes for \$600,000 through 9-30-18 for professional services relating to the Great Hall project, Aerotropolis, and other Denver International Airport real estate endeavors (201524143).

RR15-0724 \*Amends a contract with ThyssenKrupp Elevator, Inc. by adding \$1,725,808 for a new total of \$33,366,208 to integrate 13 new conveyance units into the airport's existing conveyance maintenance contract to provide continuity of service, seamless integration, along with maintenance and operation services. No additional time has been added (201415671).

RR15-0726 \*Amends the hotel management agreement with Westin DIA Operator, LLC at Denver International Airport to include updates to the insurance requirements, common use maintenance responsibilities, and the cash management agreement. No changes to contract amount or duration (CE0A072).

RR15-0727 \*Approves a facilities lease agreement with Atlas Air, Inc. for \$11,000 annually through 12-31-16 to allow Atlas Air, a cargo carrier who provides DEN airline cargo service, to use the DHL cargo facilities to support their commercial cargo operations (201523473).

#### D. General Services - Kevin O'Neil/ Laura Perry

RR15-0729 \*Approves a \$313,486 purchase of three portable emergency power generators from Cummins Rocky Mountain for Parks and Recreation Centers and Fire and Police Stations.

RR15-0730 \*Approves a \$95,197 purchase of a replacement emergency generator from Cummins Rocky Mountain for the City and County Building.

#### E. Parks and Recreation - Scott Gilmore/ Yolanda Quesada/ Mike Bouchard

BR15-0714 Approves the designation of Lakewood Gulch Park, containing 52.0 acres, for preservation and protection as a city park located at West 10th Avenue and Perry Street,

in Council Districts 1 & 3.

- BR15-0715 Approves the designation of a portion of vacated right-of-way now part of Magna Carta Park, containing 0.2 acres, for preservation and protection as a city park located at South Colorado Boulevard and East Hampden Avenue, in Council District 4.
- BR15-0716 Approves the designation of Pasquinel's Landing Park, containing 3.4 acres, for preservation and protection as a city park located at South Huron Street and West Evans Avenue, in Council District 7.
- BR15-0717 Approves the designation of Town Center Park, containing 26.2 acres, for preservation and protection as a city park located at East 49th Avenue and Argonne Street in Council District 11.
- BR15-0718 Approves the designation of City of Unnamed 46th & Pecos Park, containing 3.5 acres, for preservation and protection as a city park located at W. 46th Ave. and Pecos Street in Council District 9.
- BR15-0719 Approves the designation of Weir Gulch Marina Park, containing 2.8 acres, for preservation and protection as a city park located at West 9th Avenue and the South Platte River, in Council District 9.
- RR15-0734 \*Accepts \$1 million from the Colorado Health Foundation to fund construction of Re-Imagine Play at Paco Sanchez Park in Council District 3.

- RR15-0720 Approves a contract with Kiewit Infrastructure Co for \$140,000,000 and through 12-31-2019 for construction management of projects located in the vicinity of I-70 East and National Western Center in Council Districts 8 & 9 (201524268).
- BR15-0692 \*Amends the Denver Revised Municipal Code to allow parking-protected bicycle lanes.
- RR15-0693 \*Dedicates right-of-way as Kensing Court at the intersection of Kensing Court and Boulder Street in Council District 1.
- RR15-0694 \*Dedicates an alley near the intersection of West 8th Avenue and Utica Street in Council District 3.
- RR15-0695 \*Dedicates an alley near the intersection of West 19th Avenue and Hooker Street in Council District 1.
- RR15-0721 \*Dedicates right-of-way as East Harvard Avenue at the intersection of South University Boulevard and East Harvard Avenue in Council District 6.
- BR15-0731 \*Approves the acquisition of rights-of-way at certain properties between approximately 40th Street and Brighton Boulevard and South Platte River for the Globeville Landing Outfall Project per the executed intergovernmental agreement between the City and the Colorado Department of Transportation in Council District 9.
