#### A. Community Planning and Development - Sarah Showalter/Councilwoman Robin Kniech

BR14-0398 Approves a text amendment to the Denver Zoning Code to allow fresh produce and cottage food sales as a home occupation.

#### B. Denver International Airport - Amy Raaz

BR14-0401 Extends through 8/31/2015 and adds \$1 million to the current contract with Waste Management for a new contract total of \$4.4 million for trash and recycling services at Denver International Airport (CE96014-01).

#### C. Finance - Lupe Gutierrez/Jeannie Springer

BR14-0425 Authorizes the issuance of up to \$12 million in 2014 City & County of Denver General Obligation fixed rate, tax-exempt Mini-Bonds sold in \$500 denominations to fund Better Denver Bond Program projects identified by the Better Denver Bond Project Team.

BR14-0420 \*Appropriates \$350,000 in Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) grant funding based on a letter of intent and authorizes purchase of capital equipment from the Denver Police Department Special Revenue Fund budget.

#### D. Parks and Recreation - Scott Rethlake/Julie Lehman/Doug Woods

BR14-0414 \*Approves a license agreement with El Jebel Shrine Association for use of the paved driveway at Willis Case Golf Course to access their adjacent property.

BR14-0415 \*Approves a contract with Summit Services, Inc. for \$1,083,402 through 10-31-16 for City-wide maintenance of landscape medians (PARKS-201415856-0000).

#### E. Public Works - John LaSala/Nancy Kuhn

BR14-0416 \*Amends a contract with Huitt-Zollars, Inc. to add \$219,014 for a contract total of \$1,095,023.36 for design and construction services at 4th Avenue and University Boulevard (CE91238-2).

RR14-0421 \*Approves the subdivision plat for Lowry Filing No. 26 located between 11th Avenue, Yosemite Street, and Lowry Blvd. in Council District 5.

RR14-0417 \*Dedicates a parcel of land as West Floyd Avenue near the intersection on West Floyd Avenue and South Ingalls Street in Council District 2.

RR14-0418 \*Grants a revocable permit, subject to certain terms and conditions, to SSP Colfax Marketplace, LLC, their successors and assigns, to encroach into the right-of-way with balconies, cantilevered building, awnings, and signage at 1020 E Colfax Ave in Council District 10.

F. Purchasing - Kris Deutmeyer

BR14-0413 \*Adds \$525,000 to the contract with Schur Success Auction and Appraisal (for a contract total of \$1,000,000) for vehicle auctioneering services (CE12022).

G. Technology Services - Patrick Klein

BR14-0422 \*Authorizes a \$223,391.39 capital purchase of storage area network equipment from World Wide Technologies, Inc. to increase data storage capacity.
