I. DEPARTMENTAL MATTERS IN THE REGULAR COURSE OF BUSINESS:

A. Mayor's Office - Anthony Aragon

RR14-0057 * Approves the Mayoral appointment of Mitchell McKee to the Denver Early Childhood Council for a term effective immediately and expiring on June 30, 2016, or until a successor is duly appointed.

RR14-0054 * Approves the Mayoral appointment of Connie O'Murray to the Downtown Denver Business Improvement District for a term effective immediately and expiring December 31, 2016.

B. Excise and Licenses - Judy Steele

BR14-0064 * Adds \$140,000 to the alarm management revenue contract with PMAM through the end of the contract in December 2014 for administering the City's burglar alarm system, issuing and renewing permits, and tracking false alarms for a total contract amount of \$780,000 since 2010. The vendor receives a 12% fee on total revenue collected, revenue has exceeded projections to date, and the contract is expected to be rebid in the next round (CE05013-02).

C. Office of Human Resources - Meredith Creme

BR14-0059 * Changes the pay grade of Director of Environmental Programs from 818-E to 819-E, and abolishes the Manager 1 and Manager 2 classifications in the Classification and Pay Plan for City employees.

BR14-0060 * Changes the title from Undersheriff to Sheriff in the City employee Classification and Pay Plan.

BR14-0061 * Revises the Short Range, Community Rate, and Training & Intern pay schedules and changes the pay grade for Golf Starter/Ranger, Mayor's Youth Worker, Recreation Aide, and Usher to coincide with the State increase in minimum wage.

D. Public Works - Nancy Kuhn

BR14-0066 * Approves a contract with TransCore ITS for \$921,101.33 for the installation of a new centralized traffic signal control system at the Traffic Management Center (201314013).

BR14-0067 * Approves the Public Works annual work program, which is included in the 2014 budget, and waives the need for individual Council approval for any contracts above \$500,000 for any of the identified work.

RR14-0044 * Dedicates a parcel of land as part of public alley right-of-way between Logan and Grant streets and 7th and 6th avenues as part of the SeventhLog project in Council District 10.

RR14-0045 * Dedicates a vacant parcel as part of the public right-of-way of W. Mexico near its intersection with S. Irving in Council District 2.

- RR14-0046 *Dedicates a vacate parcel of land as a public alley between Blake and Walnut streets and 40th and 38th avenues in Council District 8.
- RR14-0047 *Dedicates a vacate parcel as an alley north of Harvard Gulch between S. Franklin and S. Humboldt streets in Council District 7.
- RR14-0048 *Dedicates a vacant parcel as part of the public right-of-way of W. Florida near its intersection with S. Knox Ct. in Council District 2.
- RR14-0049 *Dedicates a parcel of vacant land as part of the public right-of-way of S. Garfield located near its intersection with Iliff Ave. in Council District 6.
- RR14-0050 *Dedicates a parcel of land as a public right-of-way at S. Grove St. between W. Jewell Ave. and W. Bails Pl. in Council District 2.
- RR14-0051 *Dedicates a parcel of land as a public right-of-way at W. Bails Pl. between S. Grove St. and S. Irving St. in Council District 2.
- RR14-0052 *Dedicates a parcel of land as a public right-of-way at S. Hooker St. between W. Bails Pl. and W. Jewell Ave. in Council District 2.
- RR14-0053 *Dedicates a parcel of land as a public right-of-way at 13th Ave., near the intersection of Holly St. in Council District 5.

E. Purchasing - J.D. Whiteman/Jessica Skibo

- BR14-0062 *Changes emergency purchasing procedures per the recommendations of a recent audit and raises the dollar level not subject to bidding procedures from \$5,000 to \$10,000.
- BR14-0065 *Approves a \$1,000,000 master purchase order with Neve's Uniforms & Equipment, Inc. for uniforms for the Denver Fire Department (UNIFORMS_DFD__0006A0112).
- BR14-0063 Increases the formal bidding threshold to \$50,000 and over (from the current \$25,000 and over) and changes the informal bidding threshold to less than \$50,000 (from the current less than \$25,000).
